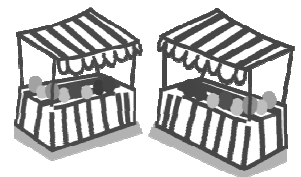

you bless its growth.

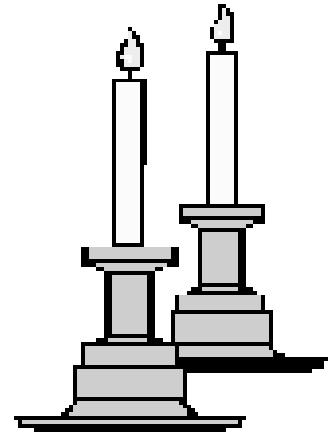
