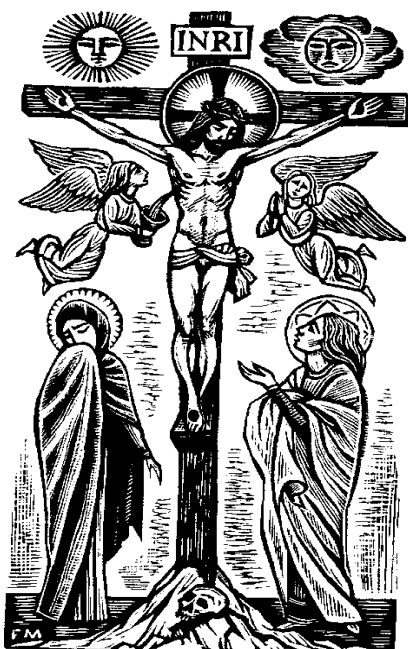
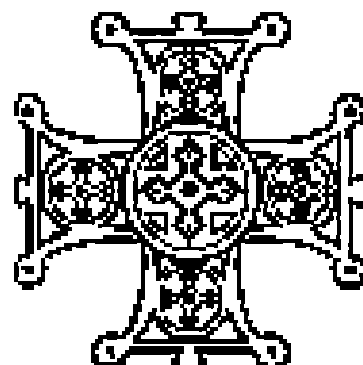

### **The New Translation - The Mystery of Faith**

One example of this is our belief in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. We believe that Christ is truly present but we can't explain it. The priest shows us the host and then the chalice. Then he genuflects and says 'The mystery of faith'.





We continue with one of three responses. These are all different from the ones we have been used to and they come directly from the New Testament.

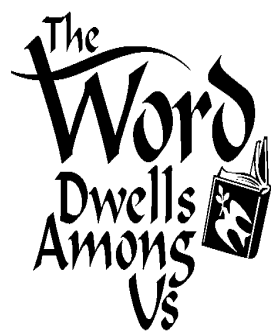


Volunteer Guides and Welcome's needed for Heritage Open Days:

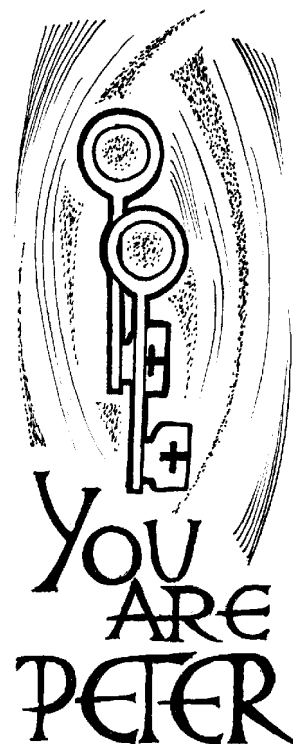
**1. I thank you, Lord, with all my heart:
