## **August 28th 2011 - 22nd Sunday of the Year (A) The New Translation - Lord I am not worthy**

As the priest invites us to receive Holy Communion, he will say 'Behold', rather than 'This is', 'the Lamb of God'. 'Behold' means 'to look at' and is our invitation to adore Christ who we are about to receive in Holy Communion. We are used to saying 'Lord I am not worthy to receive you' ... This will change to: 'Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed'.

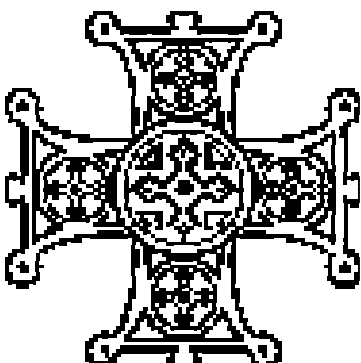


This is almost exactly what the Roman

Centurion said when he came and begged Jesus to heal his servant.

When Jesus says he will come to the Centurion's house, the man knows that Jesus doesn't need to do that, that just his word will be enough.

The Centurion says: 'Lord I am not worthy to have you come under my roof, but only say the word and my servant will be healed'.

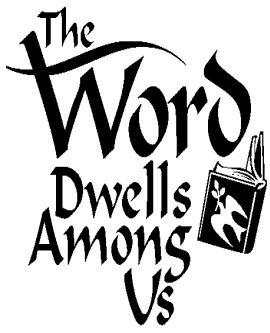

in the shadow of your wings I rejoice.

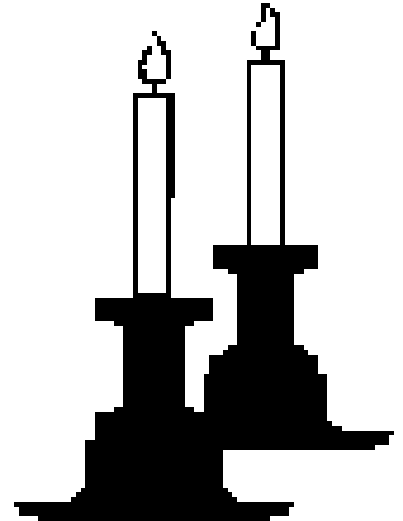
