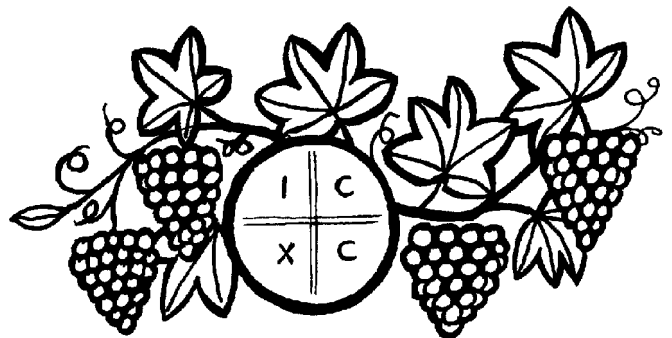

PASTORAL PROVISION IN THE DEANERY OF NORTH STAFFORDSHIRE.

Following the meeting of the deanery clergy last Tuesday, an announcement is being made in every parish bulletin this weekend to alert parishioners to the effects of clergy moves in the deanery.



In the first few months of 2012 it will be impossible for vacant posts in the deanery to be filled quickly, or for priests to be found to cover all Masses which are currently offered (Fr David Newell will soon be leaving Goldenhill and Kidsgrove, and Fr Julian Booth will soon be leaving Biddulph and Packmoor).



In consultation with the diocese, it has been decided that only one Mass of the Sunday obligation can be provided in the affected churches. The Dean, Fr Peter Weatherby, is responsible for arranging priests to cover these Masses, which is not an easy task.

Please pray for these parishes, and for vocations to the priesthood.

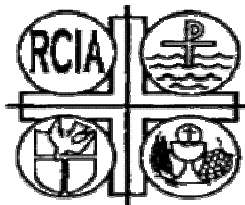
