This show is different, because the stock will be available to try on and buy on the night! The stock being shown is from major retail chains, i.e. M&S etc, at a greatly reduced price!

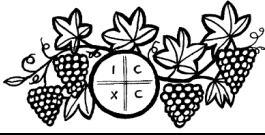

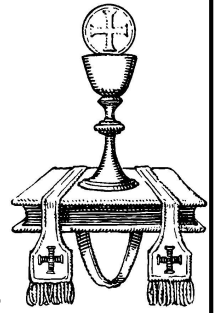

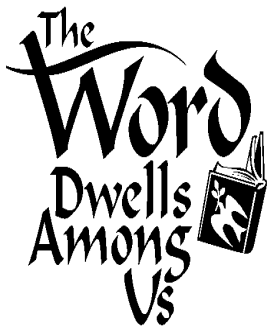
