
THIS WEDNESDAY 16TH NOVEMBER AT

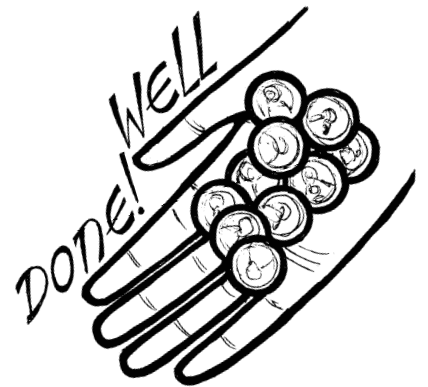
