We phone on weekday mornings between 9.30 and 12.30.

We are currently phoning 85 people each week and in December we made 399 calls. Our clients enjoy receiving the calls and often tell us how it breaks the monotony and cheers them up.

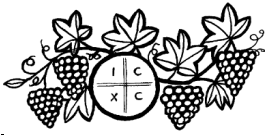
