their lives and are open to the possibility of a vocation to the priesthood or religious life.

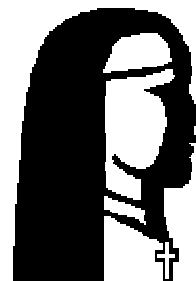
The event will provide "Fellowship, Catechesis, Confession and

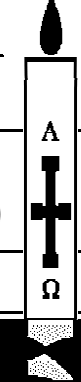

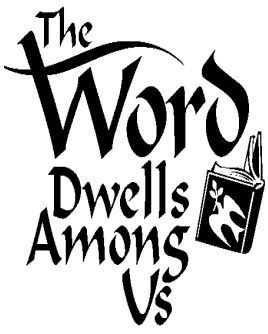

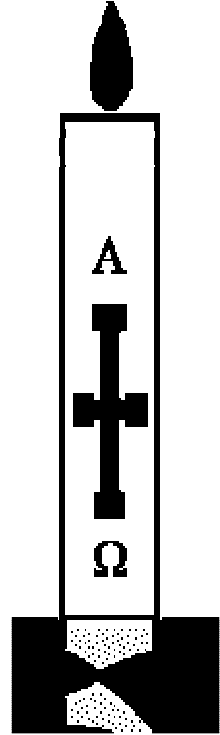
2. I will bless the Lord who gives me counsel,
