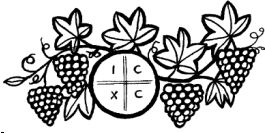



these worthy causes.

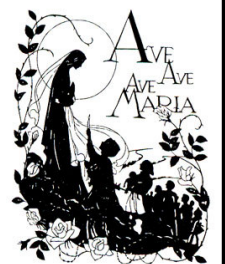
