Reflection for the 4th Sunday of Easter

The image of the Good Shepherd is a powerful one. Psalm 23 is arguably the best known of all the psalms. Many people who know nothing of the rest of the Bible can quote the psalm almost verbatim from memory. It speaks of level of comfort and care which is a universal longing, something that, in our heart of hearts we share with the rest of humanity.






There is much injustice in the world. Perhaps the root of injustice itself, 'man's inhumanity to man,' is our failure to model the Good Shepherd in our everyday life. How different would our world be if each of us forgot our own need of the Shepherd's care and put our energy to extending the Shepherd's touch to those whose need is so much greater than our own.

With God's help, we can bring light into another person's darkest moments. We can shelter them in the midst of their enemies. We can show them the goodness and mercy that we expect to follow us all our days.
