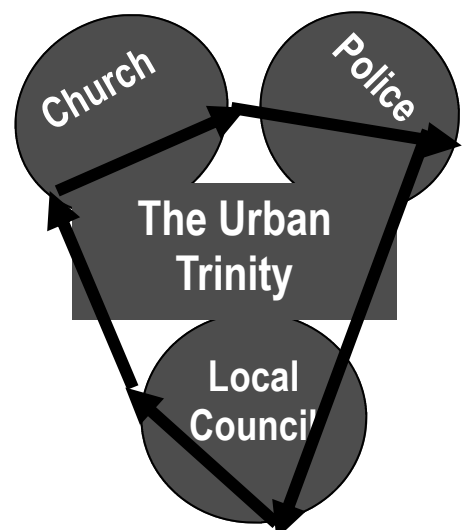
**(THE CHURCH IN ACTION IN THE

What is a STREET PASTOR?

Street pastors are local Christians who have a concern for their community and who are trained by professionals, such as the police and drugs awareness panel.

They are part of a team that goes out at night to engage equally with people of all faiths and none, where they are, on their ground and on their terms.

To be eligible to take part, volunteers must be aged 18 or over (*no upper age limit,*) have been a member of a recognised church for at least a year, be able to commit in the first year to about 50 hours of training and go out at least one night a month.
