their families.**

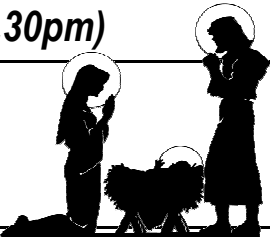
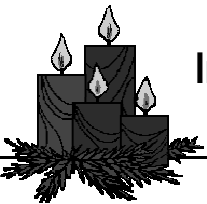
