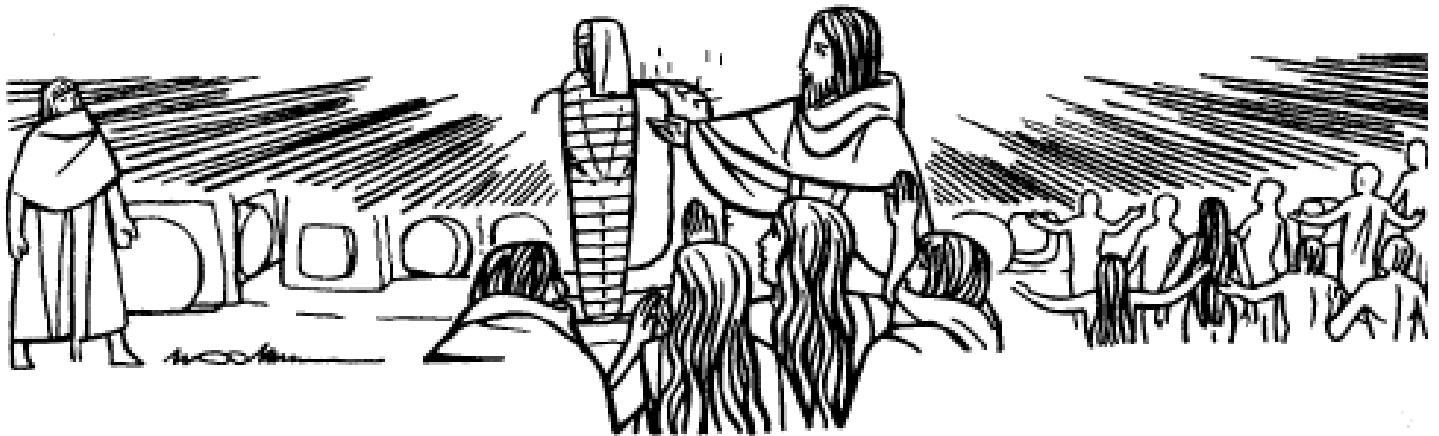

Today we are invited to ponder on Jesus Christ's role in our existence as the "source of our life and resurrection."

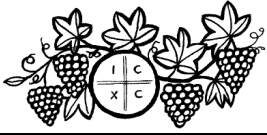
