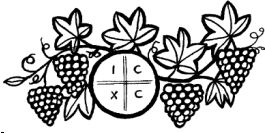
**The people in Chingombe want to learn English, they need to be able to speak English if they want to get a good job, (no one speaks Cibemba except in the bush!)**

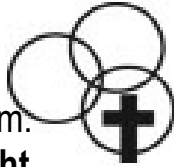

he conducts his affairs with honour.

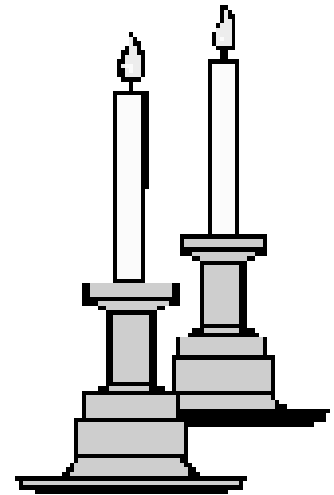
