#### **A MESSAGE FROM FR. PHILIP**

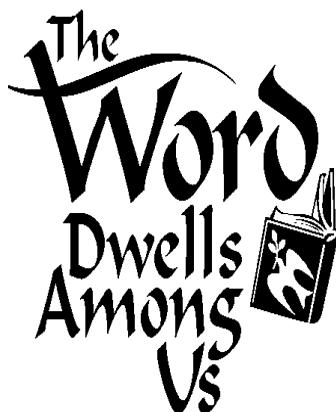
Bible Alive is a Catholic scripture magazine which offers a reflection on the daily and Sunday readings.

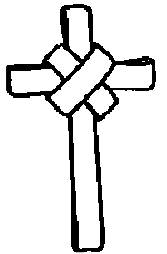

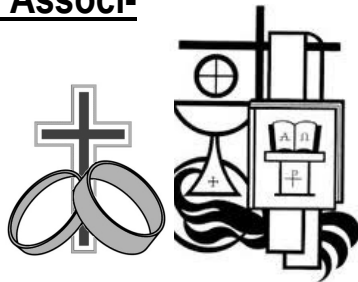
