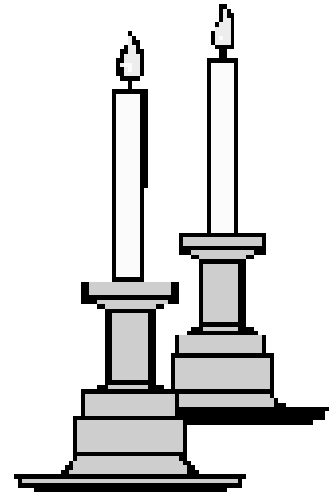
3. Bless your servant and I shall live
