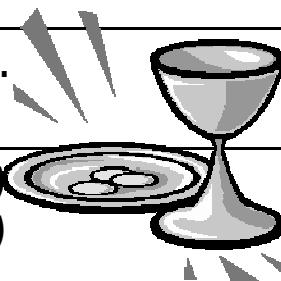

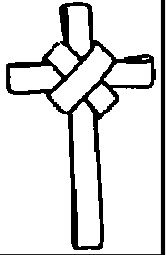

the guilt of my sin.

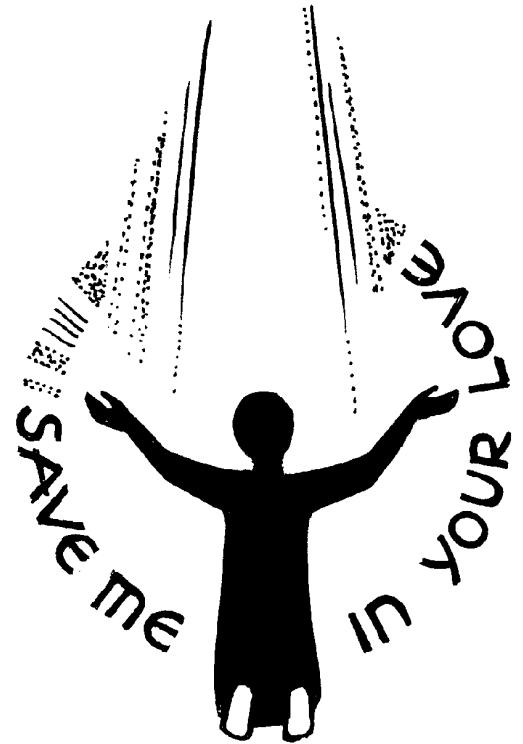
