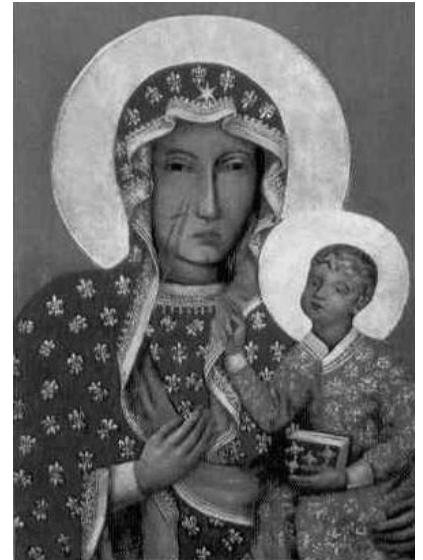

Poland's spiritual capital is recognised as Czestochowa, where the icon of Our Lady, The Black Madonna lies, said by legend to have been painted by St Luke the Evangelist on Cypress wood from a table used by the Virgin Mary in Nazareth. In the later part of the century, Faustina Kowalska, a sister of the Order of Our Lady of Mercy, has inspired a pilgrimage route to; Laggiwniki, near Krakow, where a shrine to Sister Faustina has been established. During our pilgrimage, we visit all these places, where Holy Mass will be celebrated. In addition we will visit Wadowice, birthplace of John Paul II, as well as Auschwitz, now a national monument and the famous Salt Mines at Wieliczka.

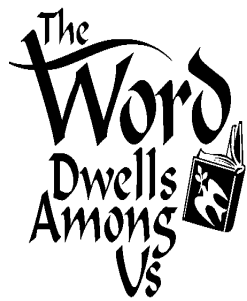

and will not give him up to the will of his foes.

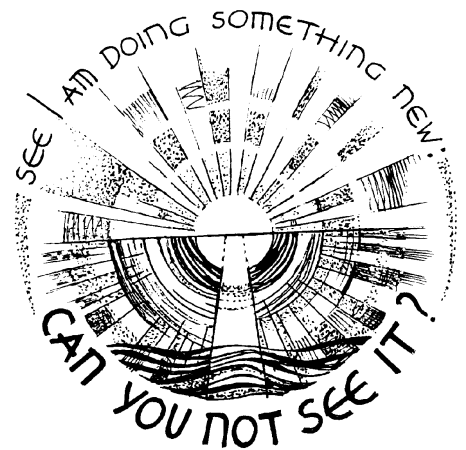
2. The Lord will help him on his bed of pain,
