Church Cleaning at Holy Trinity Thursday 3rd March

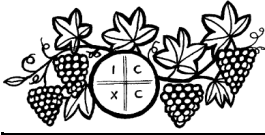
We shall be moving back into our refurbished Church next weekend, the 5th and 6th of March

If we can get as many people as possible to volunteer the task will not be too arduous and should not take too long.



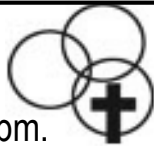

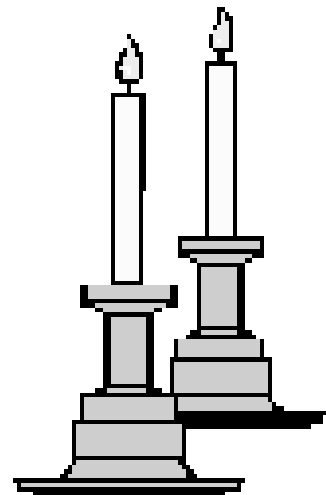
