Give up gloom—enjoy the beauty that is all around .

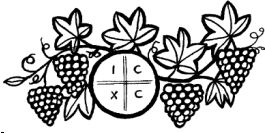
Give up jealousy—pray for trust.

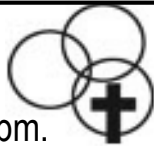

hear me and speedily rescue me.

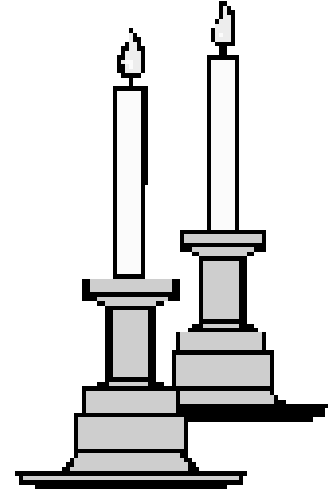
