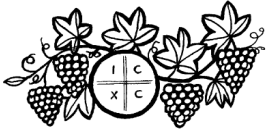

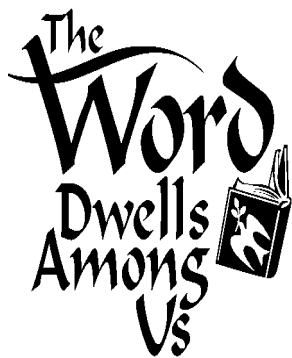

exult, you just!

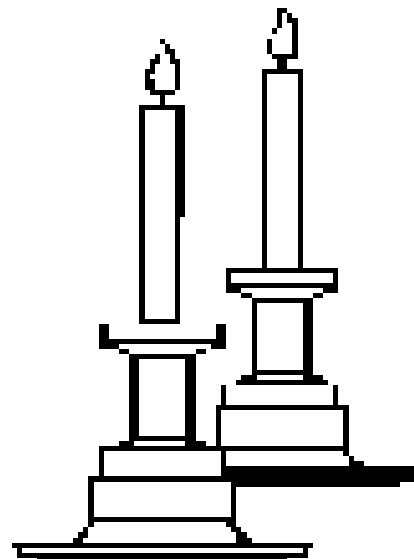
