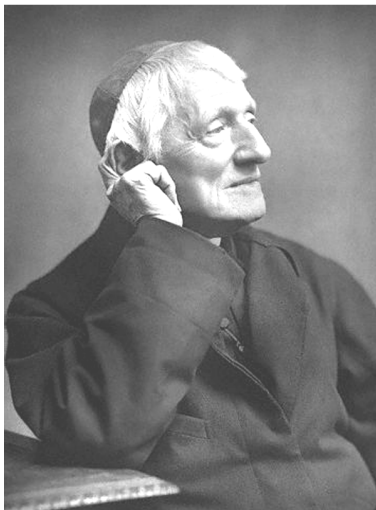

will be travelling to Birmingham.**

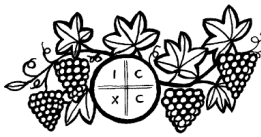

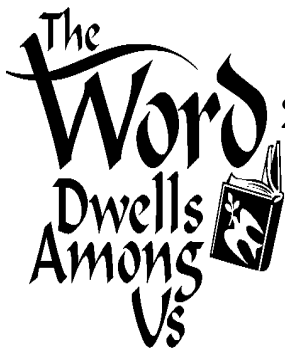

Against those who 'buy up the poor for money

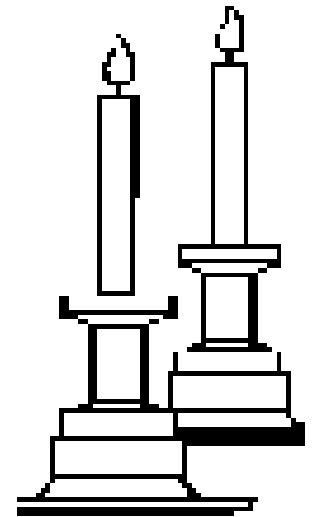
RESPONSORIAL PSALM (112)
