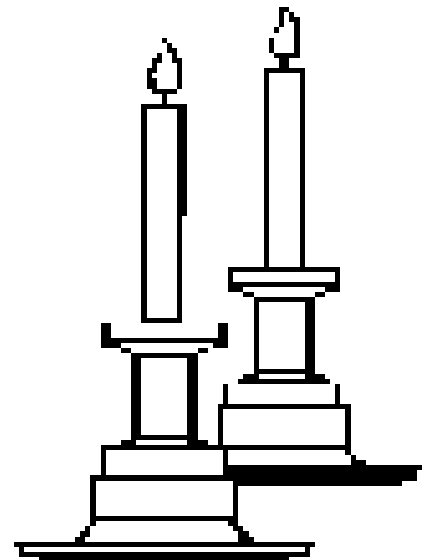
SECOND READING:
