HYGIENE ITEMS

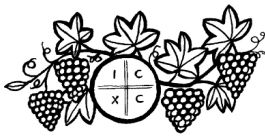
toothbrush, toothpaste, mild bar soap, comb, sponge, small towel etc.

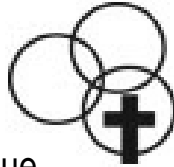

RESPONSORIAL PSALM (32)

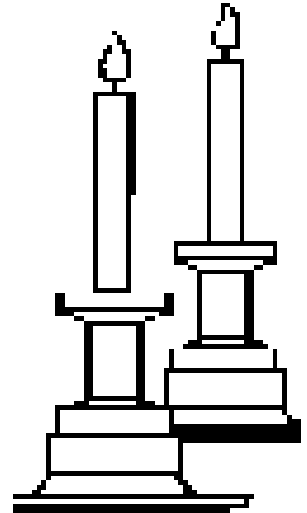
This poor man called; the Lord heard him.
