Two of the most important Saints in the Church's history. Although the two men had very different temperaments, experiences, and upbringings, they both were able to contribute their respective gifts to the Church.

They were the two men around whom the mission of Jesus to establish the Kingdom was centered and from whom it grew and spread to every corner of the world.

Each Apostle represents two very distinct roles of the Church in its mission to the world.

While St. Peter was chosen to bring most of the Jewish people into the Body of Christ, St. Paul was chosen to bring the Name of the Lord before the Gentiles and kings and before the people of Israel.

Each in his chosen way gathered into unity the one family of Christ. Both shared a martyr's death and are praised throughout the world.

Peter represents that part of the Church which gives it stability. In the Pope we see that

continuity the symbol of the unity of the church.

Paul, on the other hand, represents the prophetic and missionary role. The apostle of the gentiles.

As he said once in an unforgettable phrase:

“FOR TO ME LIFE IS CHRIST,

Please note there is no Vigil Mass at Holy Trinity on Monday evening for the Holy Day of Obligation.

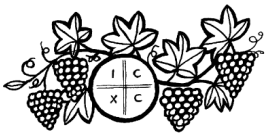
There is a Mass at the City General Chapel at 5.00pm which would fulfil your Obligation.

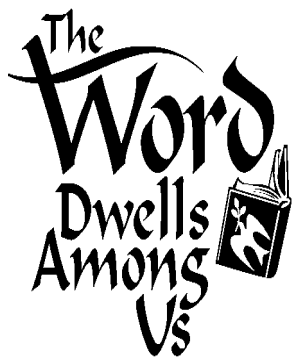

it is you yourself who are my prize.

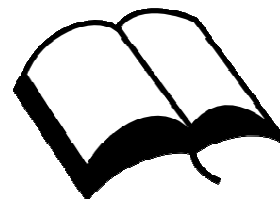
2. I will bless the Lord who gives me counsel,

at your right hand happiness for ever.

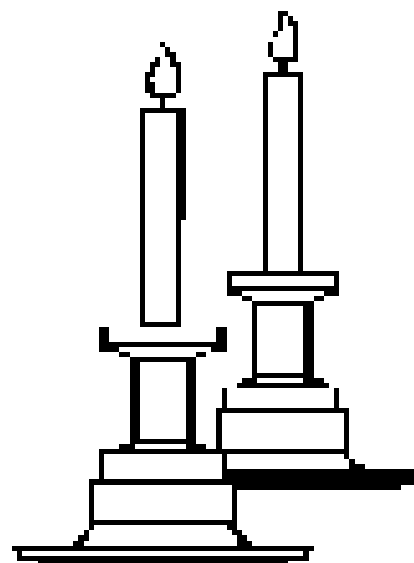
