### **PAPAL MASS SEPTEMBER 19TH:**

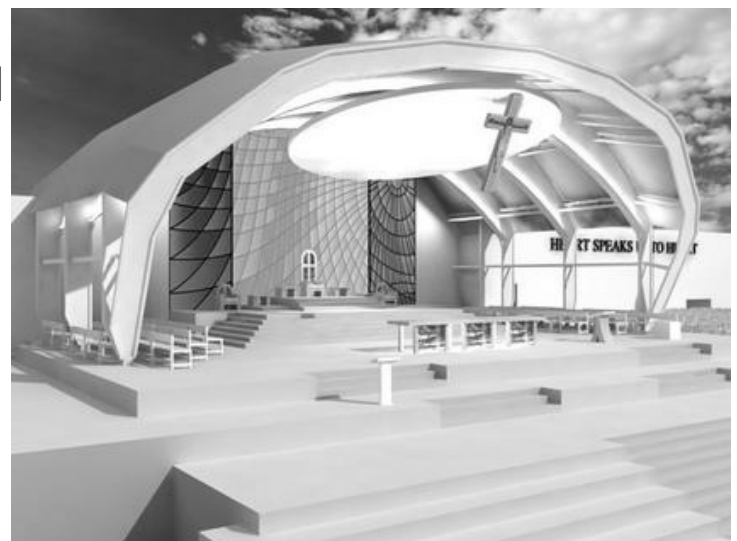
1. If you are attending the Papal Mass please collect your free copy of the handbook (Magnificat) from the Sacristy today.

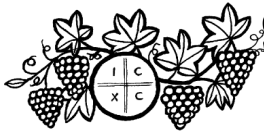
### **THE MAGNIFICAT:**


