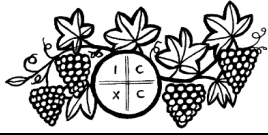

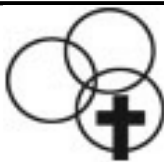

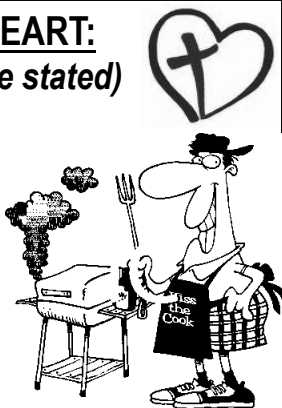

my mouth shall praise you with joy.

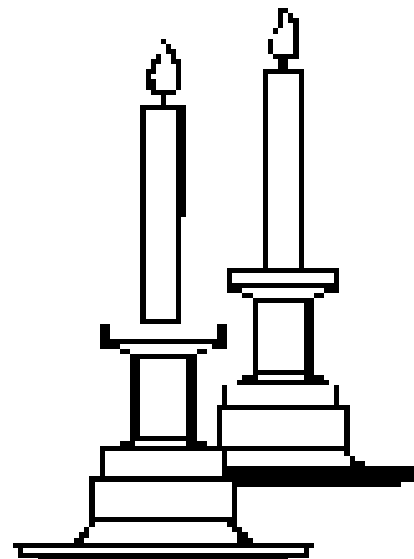

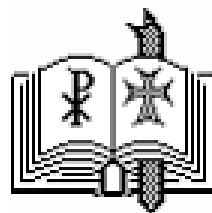
