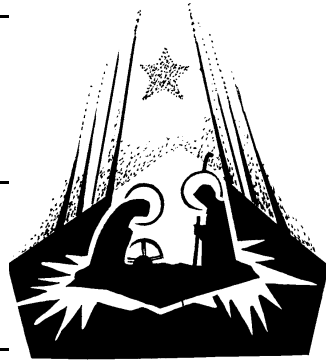

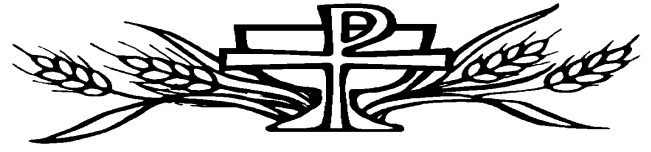

**Wanted for Ghana please:**

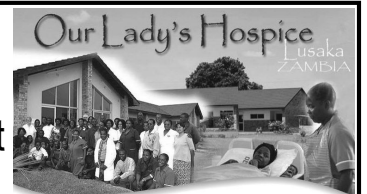

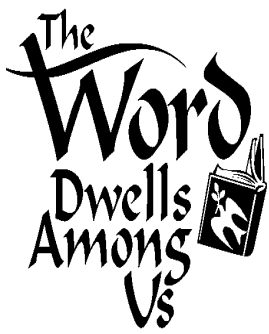
