all nations shall serve him.

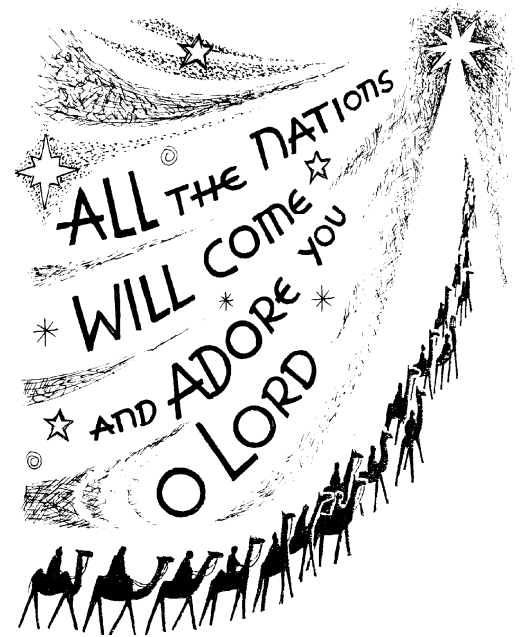
For he shall save the poor when they cry
