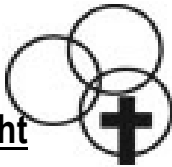

great king over all the earth.

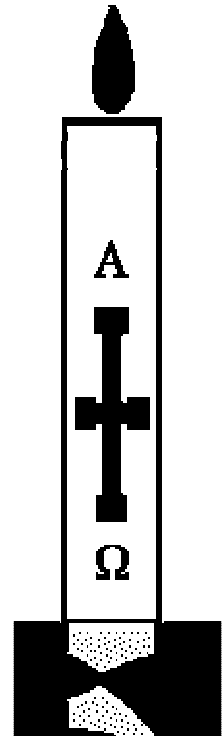
