*to be understood as to understand; to be loved*

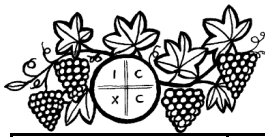
*as to love; for it is in giving that we receive;*

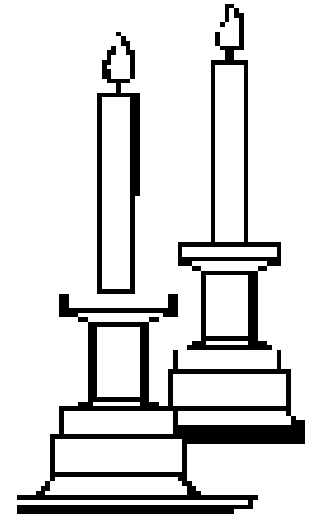
