'His love has no end.'

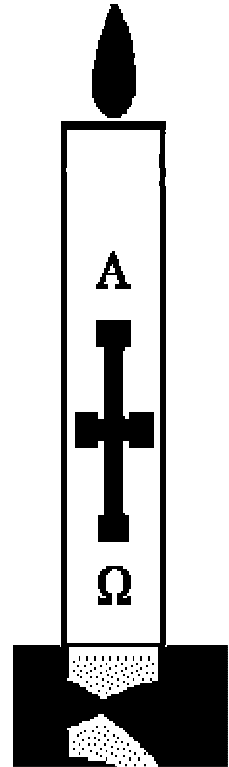
