Communion Services, Adoration.

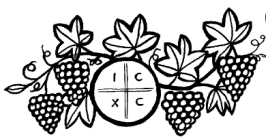
**FUNERAL SERVICES AND FUNERAL MASSES, BAPTISMS;**

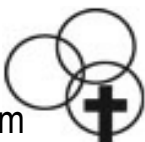

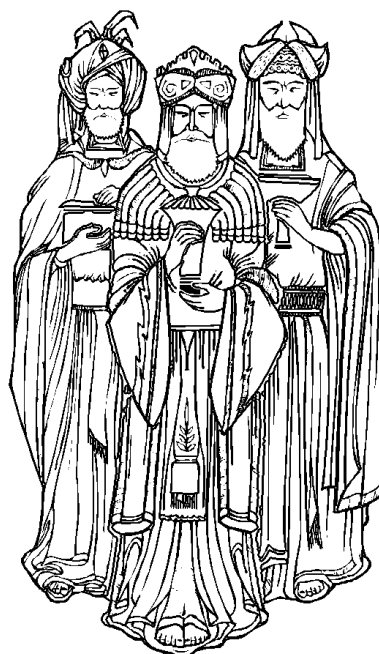

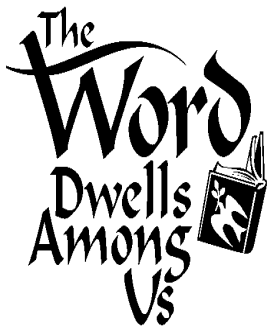

### FIRST READING:

A reading from the Book of Isaiah 60:1-6

### RESPONSORIAL PSALM (71)

All nations shall fall prostrate before you, O Lord

1. O God, give your judgement to the king,  
to a king's son your justice,  
that he may judge your people in justice  
and your poor in right judgement.
