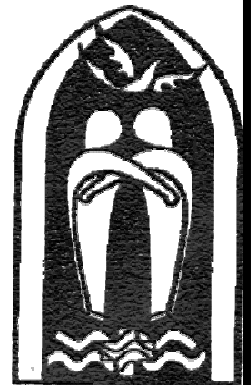

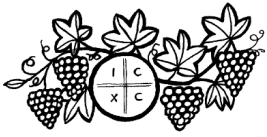
Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion:

Would all ministers try to attend the evening Mass of the Last Supper on Holy Thursday (7.30pm) to renew their promises during the service.








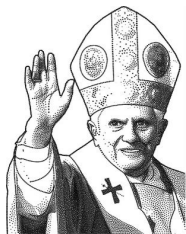

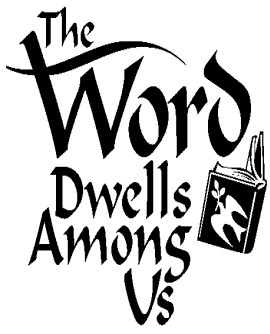
