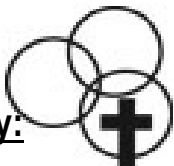

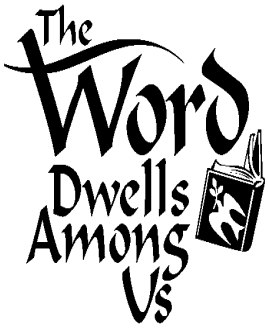

The earth is full of your riches.

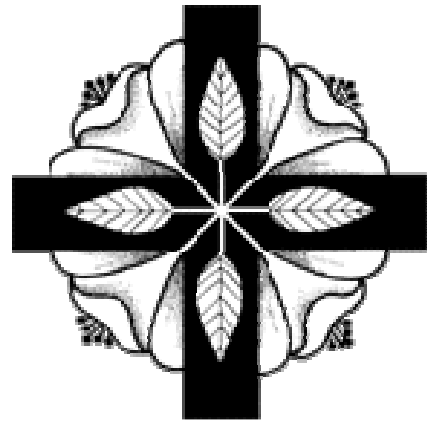
