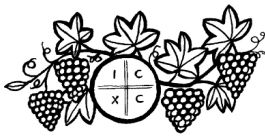

However we can inspire desire to come to Africa, not only to rest or to study Zambian culture and tradition, but also like pilgrims looking for a better way, true life. We are to help each other. So we have to be giver and receiver. Let's learn to be generous and humble in our insufficiency.
