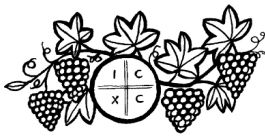

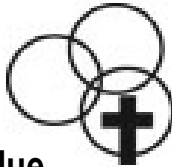

no deceit is on my lips.

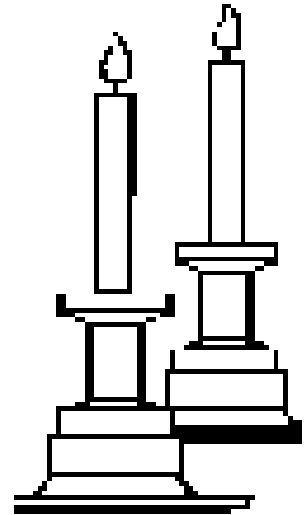
