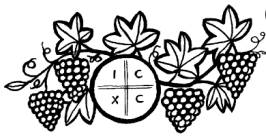

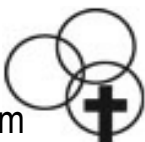

Adore the Lord in his holy court.

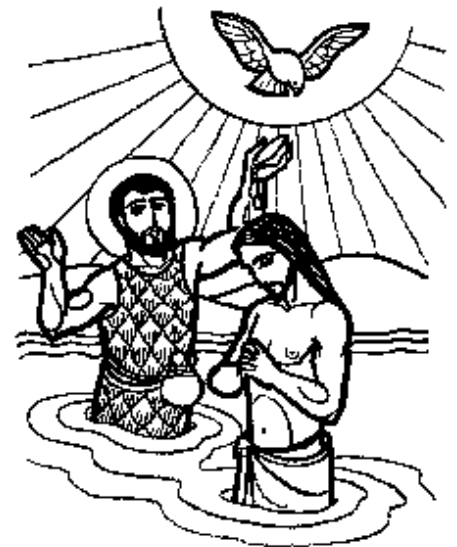
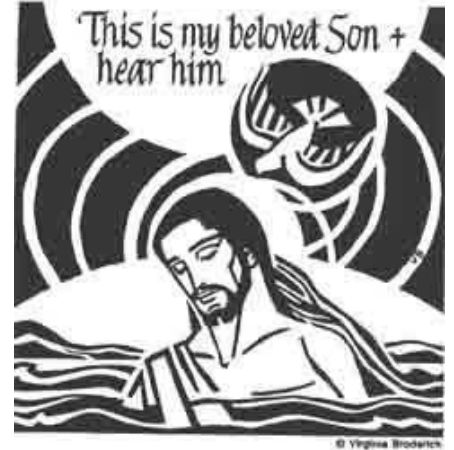
